Attending commemorative ceremonies for 35th Anniversary of Sister Collaboration Relationship with Hawaii State, and the Anniversary of 3 Kenjinkais in Hawaii States

The Commemoration of the 60th Anniversary of Hawaii Fukuoka Kenjinkai, the 50th Anniversary of Hawaiishima Fukuoka Kenjinkai, and the 50th Anniversary of Kona Fukuoka Kenjinkai were held in January 2017. Fukuoka Prefecture Governor Ogawa, Prefectural Assembly Chairman Nakao, representative council members of each party from Fukuoka Prefectural Assembly, as well as members from Fukuokaken Kaigaiiju Kazokukai participated in the ceremony. The Kenjinkai associates have gathered together for the grand ceremonies with 70 people participated in Hawaii Fukuoka Kenjinkai ceremony, 170 people participated in Hawaiishima Fukuoka Kenjinkai ceremony, and 180 people participated in Kona Fukuoka Kenjinkai ceremony. The Fukuoka Prefecture and the Hawaii State have also welcomed the 35th year anniversary of their sister collaboration relationship in 2016 since its conclusion in 1981. Various commemoration events were held for 3 days between 17th to 19th January.
